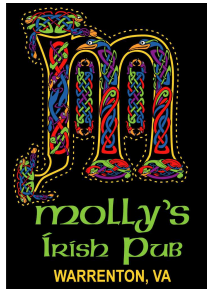

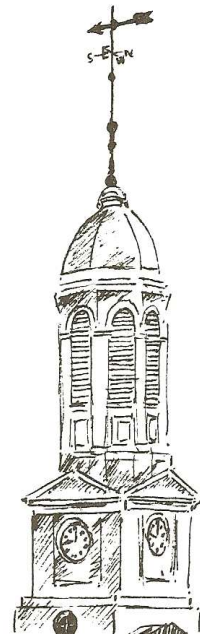
burns, and blast injuries that will retire these brave warriors from military service.

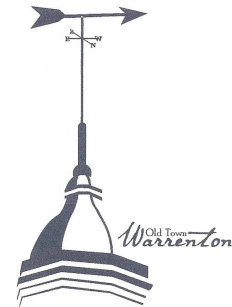

Wounded Warrior Project

One night while watching the evening news, a group of veterans and brothers were moved by the difficult stories of the first wounded service

members returning home from Afghanistan and Iraq. They realized then and there that something needed to be done for these brave individuals beyond the brass bands and ticker tape parades.

The resulting objective was to provide tangible support for the severely wounded and help them on the road to healing, both physically and mentally. What had been initially viewed as a small contribution (compared with what the warriors had sacrificed while serving our country) has become WWP's signature program: "WWP backpacks delivered bedside to wounded warriors."

Some of the much needed efforts of the WWP are the following programs, through the generous donations of private citizens, organizations and corporations, wounded warriors are provided opportunities that ease the transition to civilian life.

WWP Packs contain essential care and comfort items including clothing, toiletries, calling card, CD player, and playing cards, all designed to make their hospital stay more comfortable.

WWP Outdoors, through activities such as hunting, fishing, archery, hiking, and camping, wounded warriors continue their rehabilitation in the great outdoors.

Wound Warrior Disabled Sports Project is a partnership between the Wounded Warrior Project and Disabled Sports USA to provide year-round sports programs for severely wounded service members from the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts and the global war on terrorism.

Coping and Family Services offers many different services to help wounded warriors cope with combat stress or trauma and has a Resiliency Center full of useful information regarding PTSD.

Project Odyssey Events began with the idea to bring together warriors dealing with combat stress to offer them a chance to spend time with fellow warriors and start the healing process. Not all wounds from combat are visible.

Warriors To Work (WtoW) works with participants individually to tailor the program to their needs, skills, and interests at each step in the process.

The WWP is a non-profit organization. In 2007, \$.79 of every dollar donated went to provide services and programs for our wounded warriors and their families.
